

Larry Pinson - Is a graduate of the University of California at San Francisco School of Pharmacy in 1973, practiced pharmacy for 32 years prior to being selected for the position of Executive Secretary of the Nevada State Board of Pharmacy. He owned and operated his own pharmacy, Silverada Pharmacy, in Reno for 22 years after practicing hospital pharmacy at St. Mary's Hospital in Reno for 5 years. Larry was appointed and reappointed by two Governors to serve the maximum of 9 years on the Nevada State Board of Pharmacy, presiding over the Board for more than 8 of those years, as well as being appointed by Governor Guinn for two terms on the Nevada State Pharmacy and Therapeutics Committee. He has held an adjunct professorship with Idaho State University since 1989, and serves as a preceptor for pharmacy students for North Dakota State University, Roseman University, Chicago State University and Creighton University. Besides serving as a consulting pharmacist for numerous facilities and organizations over the years, he is a past member of the Board of Governors and Past President of the Alumni Association for UCSF. He also sits on the Executive Committee for the National Association of Controlled Substances Authorities (NASCSA). Dr. Pinson received the Bowl of Hygeia for the state of Nevada in 1984 and was selected "Pharmacist of the Year" by the state pharmacist's association in 1999.
