

RESOLUTION 99-02

WHEREAS, individual states have always had the right to regulate the practice of medicine, and;

WHEREAS, Congress is currently considering legislation that would preempt state's authority to regulate the dispensing of narcotic drugs in Schedules IV or V or combination, by a practitioner, for maintenance or detoxification treatment,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the National Association of State Controlled Substances Authorities (NASCSA) recommend that Congress not preempt states' authority to regulate the practice of medicine.
